

## HEARING AIDS LOANS

[April 2016, valid for 6 months]

It may be appropriate for families to loan equipment for use over a short period, for example, if a child has a temporary hearing loss due to glue ear.

If we have equipment available for loan, the typical cost of loan is £60 per month of use, per device.

For hearing devices with an FM microphone, or blue tooth transmitter, the cost is £60 for each part of the system. For example, if a Roger Focus is loaned, for trial, the cost is £60 for the Focus and £60 for the Roger Clip -On-Microphone. This is a total payment of £120 per month. If a further Focus device is requested for the second ear, and we have available stock, the total is £180 per month.

If over time, the decision is made to keep the loan equipment, 2 monthly payments can be deducted from the purchase cost of the device.

If a device is loaned for 12 consecutive months, and the 12 loan fees have been paid, the equipment becomes the property of the family after a year of use.
